

LESSION 2: SOCIAL GAMING: START THE CONVERSATION

INTERVIEW GUIDE:

Have you ever heard your parents or other adults talk about teens and gaming? Do your parents play online games? Pick a parent, teacher or mentor to interview about teens and online gaming. Develop 5-6 questions to ask them to start a conversation. Once you have chosen your subject for the interview, please take some time to prepare:



- Review the questions and think of follow-up questions you might want to ask for each one. Follow-up questions might also just come naturally during the discussion.
- You might want to record the interview so you can listen to it later and write down the responses. If you want to record it be sure to ask for your interviewee's permission.
- Find a comfortable place to interview your subject – their home, a coffee shop, an office – someplace that will allow you both to relax and talk freely.
